- RAD (Rental Assistance Demonstration) Subsidy conversion project Phase II environmental studies were completed on Feb 21. Test results indicated some levels of lead and benzo a pyrene in the tested soil. Environmental Solutions recommends we perform additional testing before we can plan remediation work. As of March 22, we have not received a proposal. Closing was delayed to the environmental remediation. Projected closing date is June 30, 2018.
