Financial updates & Board Action Items:

234 Essex Street—Management is still waiting on the conditional approval letter from HUD to proceed with the demolition of 234 Essex. Once received, management will need to order an environmental and 504 study. HUD will also require a resolution approving the purchase of 34 North King Street.

Insurance Claim—Brown & Brown's slip-and-fall claim for 335 Hudson Street is still in litigation, and it can take until April 2025, which is two years from the date of the open claim.

Occupancy /Vacancy updates:

This property is 98.90% occupied in available units. 234 Street has been marked as an uninhabitable unit and taken offline (no subsidy will be received).

- HUD REAC inspection: On October 18th, 2021, we received 97c. The next REAC will be scheduled in 2024/2025.
